Notes

- **Perspectives from each book** - Each book provides a different perspective of Christ's resurrection.
 - **Matthew (Israelite)** - talks about an angel descending from heaven to roll away the stone from Jesus' tomb
 - **Mark (straightforward, powerful)** - Joseph of Arimathea, a powerful member of the Sanhedrin courageously comes to ask for Jesus' body, the women are afraid at the tomb of Jesus
 - **Luke (humanitarian, public)** - one of the robbers is invited to paradise with Jesus, the crowd beats their breasts, other women were at the tomb
 - **John (eternal, divine)** - Jesus says "it is finished" (or "perfected"), Jesus tells Mary not

to touch him until he has ascended to heaven

- **Matthew 28:20** - Before this moment, Christ's ministry was only to the Jews. However, in these verses, Christ gives the directive to his disciples to preach to "all nations"
